



The Restorative System

Through Activities, Work, and Actions with Reparative-Restorative content (Toar, for its acronym in Spanish), those found responsible of serious crimes contribute to heal the harm caused to victims, communities, and territories during armed conflict.

The SJP approaches the imposition of **the first sanctions** through projects that allow the defendants of Farc-EP and of the armed forces **to fulfil their obligations** before the **Restorative Transitional Justice**, while they cement the great transformations that the country needs to flip the page of violence.
