- Case 10 collects **306 reports** delivered by civil society groups, as well as those delivered by the Office of the Attorney General about crimes committed by Farc-EP during the armed conflict.



## CRIMINAL PATTERNS

- 1 Murders, massacres, enforced disappearances, enforced displacements and sexual violence as part of a pattern of social and territorial control
- 2 The use of illegitimate means and methods of warfare and other crimes committed under the course of hostilities
- 3 Paid assassinations and attacks with explosives committed in cities by urban squads



## MOST AFFECTED REGIONS

The most affected departments were those that had presence of the structures of Farc-EP: Bloque Oriental and Bloque Sur.

In relation to enforced displacement, the majority of documented victims are concentrated in Caquetá, Vaupés, Guaviare and Arauca.
